WELCOME TO OLDHAM'S LAKEFRONT COTTAGES

HOW TO GET HERE

New Denver is located in the West Kootenay region of southeastern British Columbia on Highway 6 halfway between Revelstoke on the Trans Canada Highway #1 to the north and Nelson to the south. When you arrive in New Denver turn west on Slocan Avenue and go four blocks to Slocan Lake. Once you reach the dead end, turn left to find Oldham's Lakefront Cottages.

CHECK-IN

Check-In is between 4:00 p.m. to 7:00 p.m. on the beginning date of the lease. If you are unable to arrive between the check in times keys will be left for you inside your cottage. We will then check in with you the following morning. There is no early check-in except by prior arrangement.

CHECK-OUT

Check-out is no later than 10:00 a.m. on the Saturday ending your stay. This will be greatly appreciated by the cleaning staff. Please remember that you are responsible to ensure that all dirty dishes, cookware and eating utensils are washed, rinsed, dried and put away in the proper location. All household trash, garbage, and/or other discarded items should be properly bagged-up so to avoid spillage/leakage and properly deposited in the refuse containers located in the back shed. Under **NO** circumstances should household refuse be deposited and/or otherwise left outside as it can attract unwanted visitors. Upon departure, please leave all keys on the dining room table.

PARKING

There is room in front of your cottage on El Dorado to park two vehicles per cottage.

SEPTIC INFORMATION

Each cottage operates on a septic tank sewer system. It is very important that care is taken not to clog the septic tanks, as a rather unpleasant situation can easily result. Therefore, we ask that no food, grease, coffee grounds, or toxic substances be washed down the drains, that toilet paper only be flushed down the toilet (no sanitary supplies) and that no more than 4/6 people occupy the cottage on a regular basis.

TOWEL USE

To conserve water we are providing only two sets of bath towel/wash cloths and one beach towel per person per week. There is washer and dryer in each cottage for your use. **PLEASE** use the bath towels for the bath and the beach towels for outside. We also provide rags should you need to clean something. Thank you! (The Cleaning Staff)

CLEANING

Cleaning supplies and enough paper products (toilet paper and paper towels) for a few days are provided for your convenience. Washers and dryers are provided in each cottage.

GARBAGE AND RECYCLING

You will find garbage containers under the kitchen sink for food and general waste that can not be recycled. If you need to empty this container during your stay, you will find garbage cans in the small shed in the back yard. You will also find two recycling containers, one for paper products and one for glass, plastic, and cans.

BARBECUE

DO NOT OPERATE UNDER ANY OVERHEAD ROOF OR FOLIAGE.

TO LIGHT set control knobs to "OFF" and slowly turn on the gas supply. (Turning the gas supply on rapidly or leaving the control knobs on may activate the FLOW LIMITING DEVICE, which will severely restrict gas flow). Push and turn right control knob to "Hi". Push the igniter knob3 or 4 times or light the striker. "Ignition may perform better with the right control knob or both control knobs set at medium". If lighting with the striker insert the lighted striker through the lighting hole located at bottom right of the grill housing. If burner does not ignite, push and turn control knobs to "OFF", wait 5 minutes, then try again
